

Allocation Statement for St Bonaventure's Catholic Primary School - September 2022

As St Bonaventure's Catholic Primary School was oversubscribed, the criteria stated in their published admissions policy (available on the school and Local Authority websites) have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the school.

126 on-time applications have been received for St Bonaventure's Catholic Primary School, which has a Published Admission Number (PAN) of 60.

How the Initial Allocation of Places was made

The 60 places have been offered to the following children:

1. Catholic looked after and previously looked after children. (0 places)
2. Catholic children who are resident in the school's designated parishes St Bonaventure's and Sacred Heart (22 places)
3. Other Catholic children (12 places)
4. Other looked after and previously looked after children (1 place)
5. Children who are a Catechumen (0 places)
6. Any other children (priority given to children with siblings already at the school and then by distance from the school) (14 places with siblings, 10 others)

1 place has been allocated to a child with SEN.

Infant class size prejudice appeals - effects of infant class size legislation.

Appeals for St Bonaventure's Catholic Primary School will be heard on the basis of infant class size prejudice as the school will have two Reception classes containing 30 pupils each.
