Allocation Statement for St John's CE VC Primary School -September 2022

As St John's CE VC Primary School was oversubscribed, the criteria stated in their published admissions policy available on the school and Local Authority websites have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the school.

188 on-time applications (83 x 1^{st} preferences, 65 x 2^{nd} preferences, 40 x 3^{rd} preferences have been received for St John's CE VC Primary School, which has an Admission Number of 75.

How the Initial Allocation of Places was made

The 75 places have been offered to the following children:

- 1. Children in the care of the Local Authority or who were previously in Care but immediately after being in Care became subject to an adoption order, child arrangement order or special guardianship order. (0 places)
- 2. Those children with siblings already at St John's CE VC Primary School and who will still be there in September 2022. (27 places)
- 3. Those children living closest to St John's CE VC Primary School as measured in a direct line from the home address to the school. (48 places) The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 1.268km.

Infant class size prejudice appeals - effects of infant Class Size legislation.

Appeals for St John's CE VC Primary School will be heard on the basis of infant class size prejudice as the school will have three Reception classes containing 25 pupils, but these will grow to 30 from Year 1 when classes are mixed with higher Key Stage 1 Year Groups.
