Description of the application land

Land at Colston’s School Playing Fields Bell Hill Bristol described in the application as being also sometimes referred to ‘Colston’s Field, Colston’s Lower Field, the Field and ‘Land bordered by Welsford Avenue and Rowland Avenue to the north and west, and by the River Frome to the south’.
