

COMMONS ACT 2006 – SECTION 15(1)

Notice of an application for the registration of land as a Town or Village Green

To: every reputed owner, lessee, tenant or occupier of any part of the land described below and to all others whom it may concern.

Application has been made to the **City Council of Bristol, PO Box 3176, Bristol, BS3 9FS** under section 15(1) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons (Registration of Town or Village Greens) (Interim Arrangements) (England) Regulations 2007.

The application seeks the inclusion in the register of town or village greens of the land described in the Schedule below which is claimed to have qualified for registration as a town or village green on 10th March 2015 by virtue of the land concerned being used as of right by the inhabitants of Bristol for lawful sports and pastimes for a period of at least 20 years until the date of the application.

The application, which includes a plan of the land proposed for registration may be inspected at the following office, Legal Services, Bristol City Council Parkview Office Campus, Whitchurch Lane, Bishopsworth, Bristol BS14 0TJ between the hours of 9am and 5pm on weekdays.

If the Registration Authority is satisfied that the land described below qualifies for registration as a town or village green, it will so register the land.

Any person wishing to object to the registration of the land as a town or village green should send a statement of the facts on which the objection is based to The City Council of Bristol, Legal Services, Community Litigation Team, PO Box 3176, Bristol BS3 9FS (Ref. Legal/TD/JD5.587) on or before the **18**th **September 2015**.

Any representations that are to be taken into account by the Registration Authority in reaching a decision on the application cannot be treated as confidential and will be copied to the applicant for comment and may be disclosed to other interested parties.

Schedule

Description of the land claimed to have qualified for registration as a town or village green:

Land at Colston's School Playing Fields Bell Hill Bristol described in the application as being also sometimes referred to 'Colston's Field, Colston's Lower Field, the Field and 'Land bordered by Welsford Avenue and Rowland Avenue to the north and west, and by the River Frome to the south'.
