



## COMMONS ACT 2006 – SECTION 15(1)

### Notice of an application for the registration of land as a Town or Village Green

To : every reputed owner, lessee, tenant or occupier of any part of the land described below and to all others whom it may concern.

Application has been made to the **City Council of Bristol, PO Box 3176, Bristol, BS3 9FS** under section 15(1) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons (Registration of Town or Village Greens) (Interim Arrangements) (England) Regulations 2007.

The application seeks the inclusion in the register of town or village greens of the land described in the Schedule below which is claimed to have qualified for registration as a town or village green on 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2018 by virtue of the application land having qualified as a town or village green within the meaning of the Commons Act 2006, section 15(3).

The application, which includes a plan of the land proposed for registration may be inspected at the following office, Legal Services, Bristol City Council, City Hall, College Green, Bristol BS3 9FS between the hours of 9am and 5pm on weekdays.

If the Registration Authority is satisfied that the land described below qualifies for registration as a town or village green, it will so register the land.

Any person wishing to object to the registration of the land as a town or village green should send a statement of the facts on which the objection is based to The City Council of Bristol, Legal Services, Litigation Regulatory Community Team, PO Box 3176, Bristol BS3 9FS (Ref. Legal/TD/JD5.792) on or before **18<sup>th</sup> March 2020**.

Any representations that are to be taken into account by the Registration Authority in reaching a decision on the application cannot be treated as confidential and will be copied to the Applicant for comment and may be disclosed to other interested parties. However names and addresses will be redacted unless steps are taken as set out below

Please also be aware that anonymous representations received will, in line with general rules of evidence, be given less weight by the decision maker. Any Objector who would like their representation to be given greater weight must confirm that they have no objection to their name and address being disclosed to the Applicant, to the inspector, if appointed, and to the Public Rights of Way and Greens Committee.
