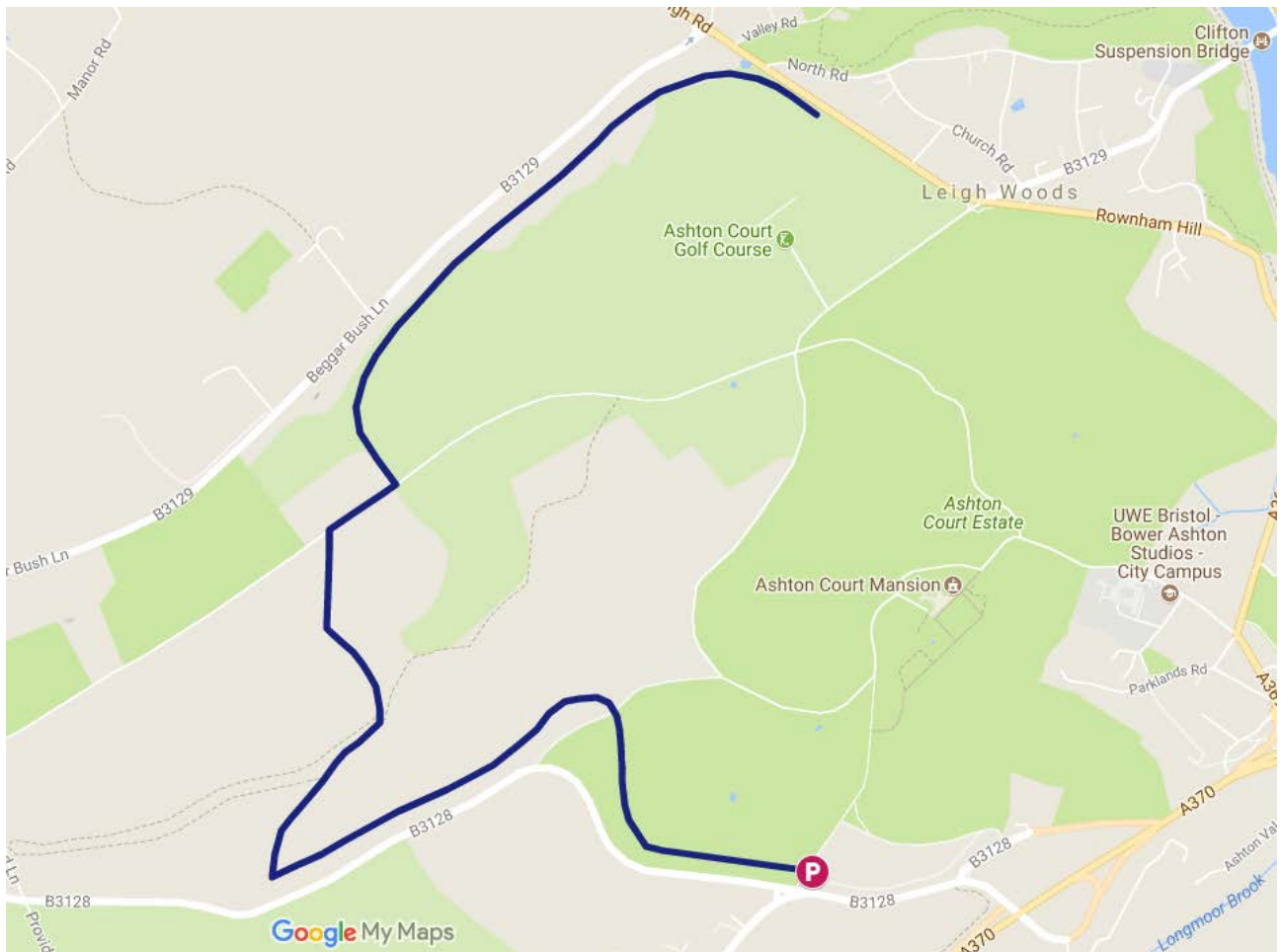




Horse riding at Ashton Court Estate

Ashton Court Estate has a two-mile long, horse trail that goes from Church Lodge car park to Clifton Lodge:



Code of Conduct

To help you and other Estate users enjoy Ashton Court, please ride considerately.

Parking

Use Church Lodge Car Park, where the trail starts.

Don't use any other car park.

Don't sweep out your horse box in the car park.

Follow marked routes

The horse trail goes from Church Lodge to Clifton Lodge.

Riding is permitted on or near to the estate drives, but not on the golf course or in the formal gardens.

Respect other users

Take care when meeting other users, especially where the horse trail crosses other routes.

Speed

Galloping is not allowed anywhere on the estate.

Safety

Take care near the miniature railway. Trains regularly let off their whistles which could spook your horse.

Some sections of the trail are multi-use or run close to the mountain bike trails, be aware of other users.

Weather

Avoid riding during very wet conditions when the ground will be damaged.
