Using the Pack

Some of the lesson plans require multiple copies of certain items such as quiz sheets and photos. In general, the pack contains everything you need to offer a comprehensive programme of SRE for all years in KS3/4. Some other resources are also referred to – though mostly in the context of extension lessons.

Unfortunately, we are not in a position to provide copies of all of these to every school, though they can be obtained from the KRIS resource service based at Greenway Centre.

Each lesson plan contains at least two exercises, but some offer more. These are intended to offer variation rather than to create an expectation that everything must be used; the exercises have been designed to offer variety within each year group to allow for different learning styles. Some extension lessons have also been offered, and it is intended that others will be offered in the future as schools offer feedback on student reactions.
