

## **September 2022 first round allocation statement for Bristol Brunel Academy**

As Bristol Brunel Academy is oversubscribed, the admissions criteria published on the School and Local Authority website have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the academy.

### **Number of applications received**

627 on-time applications (343 first preferences, 193 second preferences and 91 third preferences) have been received for Bristol Brunel Academy which has a published admission number of 232. The academy has breached the admission number for Year 7 in 2022 to 290.

5 places were required for children with the school named in their Education, Health and Care Plan.

This left 285 places to allocate using the published criteria.

### **How the initial allocation of places was made**

The 285 places have been offered to the following children:

1. Those children who are defined as Children in Care or children who were previously in care but immediately after being in care became subject to an adoption, child arrangements or special guardianship order. (5 places)
2. Those children living within the area of first priority for Bristol Brunel Academy, with siblings of statutory school age attending the academy, who will still be on roll in September 2022. (59 places)
3. Children who live within the area of first priority for Bristol Brunel Academy, who live closest to the academy as measured in a direct line from the home address to the school. (216 places)
4. Those children living outside the area of first priority for Bristol Brunel Academy, with siblings of statutory school age attending the academy, who will still be on roll in September 2021. (5 places)

The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 0.688 km.

## **September 2022 second round allocation statement for Bristol Brunel Academy**

As of 20th April, 9 places had become available at Bristol Brunel Academy for reallocation. A total of 84 applicants were still waiting so it was necessary to apply the school's published admissions criteria to determine who could be offered the places.

The 9 places were offered to:

1. Those children who are defined as Children in Care or children who were previously in care but immediately after being in care became subject to an adoption, child arrangements or special guardianship order. (0 places)
2. Those children living within the area of first priority for Bristol Brunel Academy, with siblings of statutory school age attending the academy, who will still be on roll in September 2022. (3 places)
3. Children who live within the area of first priority for Bristol Brunel Academy, who live closest to the academy as measured in a direct line from the home address to the school. (6 places)

The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 0.979m.
