

September 2022 second round allocation statement for Trinity Academy

As Trinity Academy is oversubscribed, the admissions criteria published on the School and Local Authority website have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the school.

Waiting List

Following the outcome of secondary school places on National Offer Day on March 1st, as of 26th April 2022, **45** applicants were included on the waiting list. This included those who requested to go on the waiting list, those who changed their preferences and those who applied late (applications received after 31st October 2021 were not included in the first round). The admission authority has agreed with Bristol City Council to breach the PAN to offer an additional 30 places for Year 7 entry. The Year 7 intake is 210.

1 place was required for children with the school named in their Education, Health and Care Plan.

There were **15** places to re-offer in the second round. 2 children qualified as music specialists, 2 children qualified as feeder school, 1 child qualified as a sibling, 1 child qualified from the inner priority area, 5 children qualified from the outer priority and 4 children qualified from out of area.

How the 2nd round allocation of places was made

As of 26th April 2022, the 209 places have been offered to the following children:

1. Those children who are defined as looked after children and children who were previously looked after but immediately after being looked after became subject to adoption, a child arrangements order, or special guardianship order. (3 places)
2. Those children who qualified as music specialists. (18 places)
3. Those children who are at the named Feeder School. (26 places)
4. Those children with a sibling on roll at Trinity Academy. (34 places)
5. Those children who live within the inner priority area who were randomly allocated. (32 places)

6. Those children who live in the outer priority area who were randomly allocated. (86 places)
7. Those children who live out of the priority areas who live closest to the school as measured in a direct line from the home address to the school. (10 places)
