



# Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) update

## January to March 2025

This information sheet contains the January to March 2025 update in respect of CIL monies received and CIL monies applied to schemes.

### CIL Monies Received – January to March 2025

This table identifies each CIL payment received and shows how it is apportioned in accordance with government regulations and Council processes. These require that 15% of each CIL payment is allocated to the local community (in Bristol's case this is the Area Committee area in which the development occurred). Where Neighbourhood Development Plans (NDP) are in place, the Local Component will increase to 25% of each CIL payment received from development in the NDP area, provided that it was granted consent after the NDP took effect. From 1 April 2024, 15% of each Local Component is top sliced into an Equity Fund, however the Equity Fund top slice is not applied to the 25% allocation for NDP areas.

### Neighbourhood Development Plan CIL Funding

The CIL funding identified in Brown above comprises a Local Component of 25%, arising out of development granted a planning consent in the Hengrove Neighbourhood Plan area.

### Reallocation Note

Over the past few years a surplus has built up and been carried forward from year to year in the Admin Component of CIL. It has transpired that the CIL Regulations do not allow for this to happen, and that any Admin CIL not required for the administration of CIL at any given year end is to be applied to Strategic CIL. The transfer of the sum of £927,166.00 to Strategic CIL rectifies the error.
