

Allocation Statement for Christ Church C of E Primary School - September 2023

As Christ Church C of E Primary School was oversubscribed, the admissions criteria stated on the Bristol City Council and School Website have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the school.

107 on-time applications have been received for Christ Church C of E Primary School, which has an Admission Number of **60**.

How the Initial Allocation of Places was made:

- 1. Children in the care of the Local Authority or who were previously in Care but immediately after being in Care became subject to an adoption, residence or special guardianship order. (**0** places)
- 2. Those children with siblings already at Christ Church C of E Primary School and who will still be there in September 2023. (23 places)
- 3. Those children living closest to Christ Church C of E Primary School as measured in a direct line from the home address to the school. (37 places). The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 5616 metres.

CLASS SIZE PREJUDICE APPEALS - Effects of Infant Class Size Legislation.

Appeals for Christ Church C of E Primary School will be heard on the basis Infant Class Size Prejudice.

The Reception intake will be organised into 2 classes, each with 30 pupils.

You should be aware that since the introduction of Infant Class Size Legislation in 2000, no appeals have been upheld in the parents' favour for this school.
