There is a requirement for Resource Base provision to support pupils who are able to access mainstream learning with additional support.

Details of alternative options considered and rejected: Every school in Bristol was invited to Submit an Expression of Interest to open a Specialist Provision in their school or expand their specialist provision. This is part of a wider programme to deliver an additional 450 specialist provision places in Bristol by 2024. Some schools in this programme are academies and therefore these decisions are not part of this process as the Regional Schools Commissioner is responsible for decisions relating to academies.
