

### Draft tree planting plan for Hazelbury Road Open Space

**November 2023**

A draft tree planting plan was circulated to residents and displayed in locations on the street. In addition, it was added to the consultation page on the Bristol City Council website.

We have responded to the comments as received below with more detail as a point of record.

#### What happens next?

The tree planting plan for Hazelbury Road will be kept as a potential site for future tree planting – tree planting will not take place this winter.

#### Comments received:

We have given these comments consideration and provide responses below:

Does this area need to be checked with BRERC?	All sites have been approved internally by Bristol City Councils Conservation Officer and habitat surveys that have been previously carried out have been used as a reference.
What species will be planted?	We will plant native, wildlife friendly species including Hazel, Hawthorn, Crab apple.
This is a designated SNCI.	Tree planting has been considered and deemed appropriate for this site.
Will the area be cleared and levelled – antisocial behaviour might return if this is the case.	We will minimise any necessary clearance and plant new trees in the spaces available. We will not be levelling the ground.
Will wildlife be disturbed?	All tree planting will take place during winter months with a small volunteer group. We will keep any clearance/disturbance to a minimum.
