What happens next?

Tree planting will take place between December 2023 – March 2024

Comments received: We have given these comments consideration and provide responses below. Please note, we will only respond to comments that directly refer to the consultation.

Is this area in the same field as previous tree planting?	Yes, the proposed new woodland area lies to the south of the existing woodland that was planted in the 2021-22 winter season.
Can the tree planting by the entrances be tapered to allow more visibility?	Yes, we will reduce the planting in the northern section to allow for this.
There is no opportunity to view this area on the website.	We are very sorry that you were unable to view this map on our website. The website team have been made aware and the issue has been resolved.
40% of the consultation notice refers to trees on streets.	We appreciate that this consultation notice does not directly relate entirely to woodland locations. Our project facilitates all aspects of tree planting throughout the city, including both woodlands and street trees. We will review our consultation notice and amend accordingly were appropriate.
