I aspire to see difference in the youth of Bristol and to make children go above and beyond in everything they do. I want to work with current councilors to deliver what the young people want.


#### My campaign issues are:


#### Top issue for young people is:

I want to make a positive change for my generation to the best of my ability.


#### Top issue I feel for young people is:


#### Top issue I feel for young people is:
