

Hourly pay gap

In this organisation, LGB staff earn 93p for every £1 that Heterosexual colleagues earn when comparing median hourly pay. Their median hourly pay is 7.1% lower than their Hetrosexual colleagues.




When comparing mean (average) hourly pay, LGB mean hourly pay is 3.59% lower than their colleagues.
