Allocation Statement for Avonmouth Church of England Primary School and Nursery- September 2024

As Avonmouth Church of England Primary School and Nursery was oversubscribed, the criteria stated in their published admissions policy available on the school and Local Authority websites have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the school.

45 on-time applications (34 1st preferences, 5 2nd preferences, 6 3rd preferences have been received for Avonmouth Church of England Primary School and Nursery has an Admission Number of 30.

1 place was required for children with the school named in an Education, Health, and Care Plan.

This left 29 places to allocate using the published admissions criteria.

How the Initial Allocation of Places was made.

The 29 places have been offered to the following children:

- 1. Children in the care of the Local Authority or who were previously in Care but immediately after being in Care became subject to an adoption order, child arrangement order or special guardianship order. (0 places)
- 2. Those children with siblings already at Avonmouth Church of England Primary School and Nursery and who will still be there in September 2024. (12 places)
- 3. Those children living closest to Avonmouth Church of England Primary School and Nursery as measured in a direct line from the home address to the school. (17 places)

The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 1.375 km.

Infant class size prejudice appeals - effects of infant class size legislation.

Appeals for Avonmouth Church of England Primary School and Nursery will be heard on the basis of infant class size prejudice as the school will have one Reception class containing 30 pupils.
