

# September 2024 first round allocation statement for Oasis Academy Brislington

As Oasis Academy Brislington was oversubscribed, the admissions criteria published on the Academy and Local Authority websites have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the Academy.

## Number of applications received.

453 on-time applications (280 first preferences, 91 second preferences, 82 third preferences) have been received for Oasis Academy Brislington which has a published admission number of 270.

11 places were required for children with the Academy named in their Education, Health, and Care Plan.

This left 259 places to allocate using the published criteria.

## How the initial allocation of places was made.

The 259 places have been offered to the following children:

1. Those children who are defined as Children in Care or children who were previously in care but immediately after being in care became subject to an adoption, child arrangements or special guardianship order. (3 places)
2. Those children whose sibling(s) currently attend Oasis Academy Brislington and who will continue to do so on the date of admission. (94 places)
3. Those children for whom Oasis Academy Brislington is appropriate on genuine medical grounds. (0 places)
4. Those children living closest to Oasis Academy Brislington as measured in a direct line from the home address to the Academy. (162 places)

The furthest distance offered a place under this criterion was 2.263 km.

## Second round allocation statement for Oasis Academy Brislington

As at April 29th 9 places had become available at Oasis Academy Brislington for reallocation. A total of 33 applicants were wanting to be considered so it was

necessary to apply the published admissions criteria to determine who could be offered the places at the Academy.

The 9 places were offered to:

1. Those children who are defined as Children in Care or children who were previously in care but immediately after being in care became subject to an adoption, child arrangements or special guardianship order. (0 places)
2. Those children whose sibling(s) currently attend Oasis Academy Brislington and who will continue to do so on the date of admission. (7 places)
3. Those children for whom Oasis Academy Brislington is appropriate on genuine medical grounds. (0 places)
4. Those children living closest to Oasis Academy Brislington as measured in a direct line from the home address to the Academy. (2 places)

The furthest distance offered a place under this criterion was 0.953 km.
