

September 2024 first round allocation statement for Redland Green School

As Redland Green School is oversubscribed, the admissions criteria published on the School and Local Authority website have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the school.

Number of applications received

844 on-time applications (379 first preferences, 266 second preferences and 199 third preferences) have been received for Redland Green School which has a published admission number of 232.

9 places were required for children with the school named in their Education, Health and Care Plan.

This left 223 places to allocate using the published criteria.

How the initial allocation of places was made

The 223 places have been offered to the following children:

1. Those children who are defined as Children in Care or children who were previously in care but immediately after being in care became subject to an adoption, child arrangements or special guardianship order. (9 places)
2. Those children living within the area of first, second or joint priority for Redland Green School, with siblings of statutory school age attending the school, who will still be on roll in September 2024. (83 places)
3. Children who live within the area of first priority for Redland Green School, who live closest to the school as measured in a direct line from the home address to the school. (131 places)

The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 0.824 km.

September 2024 second round allocation statement for Redland Green School

As at 9th April 2024, 14 places had become available at Redland Green School for reallocation. A total of 108 applicants were waiting so it was necessary to apply the school's published admissions criteria to determine who could be offered the places.

Second Round cut-off date for any late applications, preference or address changes was 25th March 2024. Any requests received after this date will be considered after the second round.

The 14 places were offered to:

1. Those children who are defined as Children in Care or children who were previously in care but immediately after being in care became subject to an adoption, child arrangements or special guardianship order. (0 places)
2. Those children living within the area of first, second or joint priority for Redland Green School, with siblings of statutory school age attending the school, who will still be on roll in September 2024. (1 place)
3. Children who live within the area of first priority for Redland Green School, who live closest to the school as measured in a direct line from the home address to the school. (13 places)

The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 0.894 km
