

Second Round Allocation Statement for St Mary Redcliffe CE Primary School - September 2024

It was initially possible to offer all on-time applications a place at St Mary Redcliffe CE Primary School. It then became oversubscribed.

As at 24th May 2024 6 places became available at the Academy for reallocation. There were 8 wanting to be considered. The criteria stated in their published admissions policy available on the Academy and Local Authority websites have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the Academy.

The 6 places have been offered to the following children:

1. Children in the care of the Local Authority or who were previously in Care but immediately after being in Care became subject to an adoption order, child arrangement order or special guardianship order. Or an Internationally Adopted Looked After Child (0 places)
2. Those children with siblings already at St Mary Redcliffe CE Primary School and who will still be there in September 2024. (0 places)
3. Those children living closest to St Mary Redcliffe CE Primary School as measured in a direct line from the home address to the Academy. (6 places)

The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 0.652 km.

Infant class size prejudice appeals - effects of infant class size legislation.

Appeals for St Mary Redcliffe CE Primary School will be heard on the basis of infant class size prejudice as the Academy will have two Reception classes each containing 30 pupils.
