

## CITY OF BRISTOL

### GEORGE BOON DRIVE AREA, AVONMOUTH AND LAWRENCE WESTON WARD - SPEED LIMIT AND WAITING ORDERS

The City Council of Bristol hereby gives NOTICE it proposes to make the following orders:-

- A. **Ref No. CAE/NMT/P-1292A** - City Council of Bristol (George Boon Drive, Lamplight Drive and Rose Close, Avonmouth and Lawrence Weston Ward, City of Bristol) (20 Mph Speed Limit) Order 202-, the effect of which would be to introduce a 20 mph speed limit in newly-constructed roads **George Boon Drive, Lamplight Drive** and **Rose Close**.
- B. **Ref No. CAE/NMT/P-1292B** - City Council of Bristol (Various Roads, George Boon Drive Area, Avonmouth and Lawrence Weston Ward, City of Bristol) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 202-, the effect of which would be to:-
- (a) introduce prohibition of waiting arrangements for vehicles in lengths of newly-constructed roads **George Boon Drive, Lamplight Drive** and **Rose Close**; and in **Knovill Close**; and
  - (b) introduce prohibition of waiting arrangements for vehicles in lengths of **Broadlands Drive** and **Lawrence Weston Road** at their junctions with this new development.
