**(GEORGE BOON DRIVE, LAMPLIGHT DRIVE AND ROSE CLOSE,
AVONMOUTH AND LAWRENCE WESTON WARD, CITY OF BRISTOL)
(20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202-**

The City Council of Bristol (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the lengths of roads identified as **20 MPH** in plan **TRO-24-002P** annexed hereto.
2. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
3. This order shall come into operation on _____ and may be cited as the City Council of Bristol (George Boon Drive, Lamplight Drive and Rose Close, Avonmouth and Lawrence Weston Ward, City of Bristol) (20 Mph Speed Limit) Order 202-.
