



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION
ACT 1984
SECTION 23 PEDESTRIAN CROSSING



NOTICE is hereby given that the City Council of Bristol in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and after consultation with the chief officer of police, intends to:-

1. remove the following push button controlled (pelican) crossing in the City of Bristol:

<u>Location</u>	<u>No. of Crossings</u>
Across Air Ballon Road (St George Troopers Hill ward) west of its junction with Troopers Hill Road	1 (pelican)

2. install the following push button controlled (puffin) crossing in the City of Bristol:-

<u>Location</u>	<u>No. of Crossings</u>
Across Air Ballon Road (St George Troopers Hill ward) west of its junction with Troopers Hill Road	1 (puffin)

Note: The crossing to be installed will be in the same location as the crossing proposed to be removed.
