Form for applications under Section 96a of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990

Section 96A of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 allows developers to apply for a non-material amendment to an existing planning permission.

This form has been prepared to guide applicants and their agents in preparing Section 96a applications and to facilitate swifter processing and determination of such applications.

In addition to the drawings that should be clearly labelled showing the approved plans and the changes that are proposed, applicants are also required to provide a written description of the changes below and any explanation regarding the reason for the change. An applicant may also wish to set out why they consider any amendment to be non-material, however ultimately the Local Planning Authority must be satisfied that the amendment sought is non-material in order to grant an application under section 96A of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.
