AVON STREET, TEMPLE WAY AND TEMPLE WAY UNDERPASS, BUS LANE AND PROHIBITED AND PRESCRIBED MANOEUVRES - TRAFFIC ORDERS

The City Council of Bristol hereby gives NOTICE it proposes to make the following traffic orders in connection with proposed remodelling at the junction of Avon Street and Temple Way:-

A. **Ref: CAE/NMT/P-1288A** - City Council of Bristol (Temple Way, Lawrence Hill, City of Bristol) (Reserved Bus Lanes) Order 202-, the effect of which would be to introduce:-

1. a southbound offset bus lane in **Temple Way (lane 2)** southbound carriageway, north of its junction with Avon Street for a length of 32 metres - this is currently the nearside eastbound off-slip lane emerging from **Temple Way Underpass**; and
2. a southbound bus lane in the nearside lane of **Temple Way** southbound carriageway, south of Avon Street for a length of 36.5 metres;

for use by buses, pedal cycles, public service vehicles, solo motor cycles and taxis, and which would effect a length of continuous southbound bus lane on **Temple Way** either side of Avon Street junction mouth.

Standard exemptions would be permitted for each separate length as appropriate.

B. **Ref: CAE/NMT/P-1288B** - City Council of Bristol (Avon Street, Temple Way and Temple Way Underpass, Lawrence Hill Ward, City of Bristol) (Prescribed Manoeuvres and Prohibited Manoeuvres) Order 202-, the effect of which would be:-

1. to introduce prescribed straight ahead movement in middle and offside lanes of **Temple Way** northbound carriageway, opposite its junction with Avon Street;
2. to remove prescribed left turn movement from **Avon Street** into southbound **Temple Way** and supersede with the introduction of a prohibition of left turn movement from **Avon Street** into southbound **Temple Way**;
3. to retain the prescribed straight ahead movement in the southbound carriageway lanes of **Temple Way Underpass** at its junction with **Avon Street**;
4. to remove the prescribed left turn movement from **Temple Way lane 2** at its junction with **Avon Street** which is currently the nearside eastbound off-slip lane emerging from **Temple Way Underpass** - this would become the bus lane proposed in item A.1 above;
5. to introduce prescribed left turn from southbound nearside lane of **Temple Way** into **Avon Street** - this would also supersede the existing prohibition of right turn from this **Temple Way** nearside southbound lane into the adjacent middle lane; and

6. to vary the City Council of Bristol (Various Roads, Temple Gate Area, Central and Lawrence Hill Wards, City of Bristol) (Prescribed Manoeuvres and Prohibited Manoeuvres) Order 2018 in so far as it relates to the provisions proposed to be removed or brought forward as per items as 2, 3, 4 and 5 above – all other remaining provisions in that 2018 order would continue unaffected.
