

CITY COUNCIL OF BRISTOL

(AVON STREET, TEMPLE WAY AND TEMPLE WAY UNDERPASS, LAWRENCE HILL WARD, CITY OF BRISTOL) (PRESCRIBED MANOEUVRES AND PROHIBITED MANOEUVRES) ORDER 202-

The City Council of Bristol (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following order:-

Commencement and citation

1. This order shall come into operation on _____ and may be cited as the City Council of Bristol (Avon Street, Temple Way and Temple Way Underpass, Lawrence Hill Ward, City of Bristol) (Prescribed Manoeuvres and Prohibited Manoeuvres) Order 202-.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this order “**enactment**” means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;
- (2) Any reference in this order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

Prescribed Straight Ahead

3. Every person shall cause any vehicle to proceed straight ahead in the road at any location where this is illustrated as “**Prescribed Straight Ahead**” in plan TS22_04TRO annexed hereto.

Prescribed Left Turn

4. Every person shall cause any vehicle to make a left turn movement in relation to the roads at any location where this is illustrated as “**Prescribed Left Turn**” in plan TS22_04TRO annexed hereto.

Prohibition of Left Turn

5. Save as provided in Article 6 of this order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to make a left turn movement in relation to the roads at any location where this is illustrated as “**Prohibited Left Turn**” in plan TS22_04TRO annexed hereto.

Exemption for emergency services

6. Nothing in Article 5 of this order shall apply to any vehicle being used for fire and rescue service, ambulance or police purposes in an emergency.

Variation of order

7. The City Council of Bristol (Various Roads, Temple Gate Area, Central and Lawrence Hill Wards, City of Bristol) (Prescribed Manoeuvres and Prohibited Manoeuvres) Order 2018 is hereby varied and shall have effect as though:-
- (a) in Article 5 thereto the words and drawing number “and in plan **T231-222 Rev B**” were omitted;
 - (b) in Article 8 thereto the words and drawing number “and plan **T231-222 Rev B**” were omitted;
 - (c) in Article 10 thereto the words and drawing number “and plan **T231-222 Rev B**” were omitted; and
 - (d) plan **T231-222 Rev B** annexed thereto were omitted.
8. The provisions of this order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from the provisions of any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by any other enactment.
