### **(VARIOUS ROADS, CITYWIDE – ASHLEY, BEDMINSTER, BISHOPSTON & ASHLEY DOWN, BRISLINGTON WEST, REDLAND, SOUTHVILLE AND ST GEORGE WEST WARDS, CITY OF BRISTOL) (CYCLE PARKING PLACES – CYCLE HANGARS) MINOR ORDER 2025**

The City Council of Bristol hereby gives NOTICE that on 30<sup>th</sup> January 2025 it made a minor traffic order which relates solely to one or more parking places provided by means of stands or racks for bicycles pursuant to section 63 of the Road Traffic Regulation 1984 Act, as amended, the effect of which is to authorise parking places for the waiting of cycles to be used at all times so as to provide the necessary part of the highway in which cycle parking hangars will be installed.

The cycles parking places will each be 2.6 metres in length by 2.1 metres in width and aligned parallel to the kerb on the carriageway at the locations as specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

The hangars will provide secure parking for pedal cycles and are for the use of persons who have paid the relevant subscription fee in order to hire an allocated space in a cycle hangar which is being operated as part of a community scheme approved by the City Council.

#### **Further Information available from 6<sup>th</sup> February 2025**

The order will come into operation on **24<sup>th</sup> February 2025** and copy thereof, together with a Statement of the Council's Reasons for making the order may be inspected (in paper and digital format) at the Citizen Service Point, 100 Temple Street, Bristol, BS1 6AG, between 10.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. on Monday to Friday, for a period of six weeks from the date of this Notice.

Any person who desires to question the validity of, or of any provision contained in the order on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, or on the grounds that any of the relevant requirements of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, may within six weeks after the date on which the order **was** made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
