**FEES FOR NAVIGATION AND
BERTHING OF 'CRAFT'
AS DEFINED IN THE BRISTOL
CORPORATION ACT. 1961**

Harbour Fees and Charges are under review and subject to change.

Fees for Navigation and Berthing of Craft

Annual: Applicable from 1st May 2022

- Class A Berthing per metre £130.65
- Class B Berthing per metre £117.30
- Pontoon Berth per metre £1882.0
- Club Pontoon per metre (including club discount) £156.20
- Temple Quay (without services) per metre £139.90
- Temple Quay (with services) per metre £148.50
- Pontoon Temple Back per metre £158.35
- Pontoon Hanover Quay per metre £247.15

Short Term Applicable from 1st April 2022

- 24 Hours per metre £2.20
- 48 Hours per metre £3.75
- 7 Days per metre £9.95
- 15 Days per metre £15.70

Notes:

- (i) The annual charge can be paid as follows:
 - a. in a group which is a recognised City Docks Club.
 - **10% discount** on the published scale of charges when the club committee completes a Pontoon Loan & Maintenance Agreement Form.
 - Each set of application forms must be fronted by a completed summary sheet and enclosed with the completed Pontoon Loan & Maintenance Agreement, both available from the Harbour Office.
 - No other discount is claimed.
 - b. payment methods advised on reverse of invoice.
 - c. by Direct Debit Mandate in the form of monthly instalments.
- (ii) Craft are measured overall, as berthed, **rounded up** to the nearest 0.5 metres. Berthing charges for multi-hulls are charged at 1.5 times normal berthing fees.
- (iii) All applications for annual licences must be accompanied by the original valid third party liability insurance certificate (minimum £3,000,000 cover) together with the original valid Boat Safety Certificate. Bristol City Council will charge for compulsory third party insurance on all short term licences issued for the City Docks: 85p for a 24 hour licence, £1.20 for a 48 hour licence, £2.00 for a 7 day licence and £3.90 for a 15 day licence (unless satisfactory evidence of cover is produced at the time of purchase).

Fees for Navigation only

1. Canoes/Rowing boats/Paddleboards/Sailing Dinghies less than or equal to 4m:

- 24 Hours per craft £8.65
- Annual Navigation per craft £40.45

2. Sailing Dinghies more than 4m and powered craft

- Annual Navigation per metre £44.30

Notes

- (i) Fees for sailing and powered craft permit free use of entrance lock and slipways as necessary.
- (ii) All applications for annual licences must be accompanied by a valid third-party liability insurance certificate (minimum £3,000,000 cover). A valid Boat Safety Certificate must also be produced for powered vessels.
- (iii) Bristol City Council will charge for compulsory third-party insurance on all short-term licences issued for the City Docks: 85p for a 24hr licence (unless satisfactory evidence of cover is produced at the time of purchase).
- (iv) Short term, 24hr charges, to apply from 1st April 2022.
- (v) Annual navigation licences are set at a fixed rate for the year. No pro-rata payment can be accepted.
- (vi) A postage and handling fee of £1.50 will be added for annual navigation licences.

Fees for Navigation and Storage of Craft

Annual: Applicable from 1st May 2022

- Dinghy Park per craft £265.35
- Dinghy Park Rack per craft £202.25
- Dutch Barn per craft £303.30
- Dutch Barn Rack per craft £256.95
- Canoes, Rowing Boats & Paddleboards per craft £152.65

Notes

- (i) Fees are inclusive of navigation licence and storage at Baltic Wharf.

1. Pump-out (self-operated, per token)£10.95
2. Hire of Marina type pontoons 11.1m per day up to 7 days.....£28.80
Per day thereafter.....£54.60
3. Towage per hour or part thereof (minimum charge 1 hour)..... £226.90
4. Hire of harbour vessel with crew per hour or part thereof..... £226.90
5. Attendance upon impounded craft per week or part thereof..... £73.00
6. Towing charge for impounded craft.....£226.90
7. Dedicated electricity supply (Annual Charge - not including consumption charge)....£95.85
8. Use of 'Mud Dock' boatyard per craft, per week. First two weeks..... £18.30
9. 10. Use of 'Mud Dock' boatyard per craft, subsequent weeks, per week..... £75.25
- 10.Redcliffe Bridge (per lift).*.....£350.95 (Advance Booking Required)
- 11.Boat Lift at Underfall Yard - Advance Booking Required (Maximum weight 2 tonnes) £93.10
- 12.Hire of flatter per day£84.45
- 13.Transport to and from each way.....£84.45
- 14.Laundry Token.....£7.70

General Notes

1. All craft in the City Docks are liable to pay the appropriate short-term fee and must apply for a licence if remaining longer than 30 consecutive days.
2. Annual fees relate to the year ending 30th April. A plan showing all annual berths is available from the Harbour Office.
3. Annual fees are reduced by 1/12th for each expired month in the licencing year commencing 1st May, subject to a minimum payment being received equal to a quarter (i.e. 3 months) of the annual fee. Excludes Table II. See Note (iv).
4. **Refund of Surrendered Licences.** A Refund Application Form, obtainable on request from the Harbour Office, must accompany the surrendered licence. Refund applications will not be available on or after 1st February. A licence may be surrendered at any time before 1st February to claim a refund for each complete month remaining unexpired at the time the refund application is received at the Harbour Office.
5. A 50% discount on all charges is available to Youth Organisations, approved by Bristol City Council.
6. Charges include VAT at the appropriate rate where applicable. Exempt charges are marked with an asterisk.
7. Where the fee is calculated per metre, the length of the craft shall be measured overall, as berthed, rounded up to the nearest 0.5 metres.
8. Payments for short term licences may be made to:

(15 day, 7 day, 48 hour, 24 hour fees only)
 - Lock Keeper's Office, Netham Road, Bristol
(15 day, 7 day, 48 hour, 24 hour fees only)

9. A photographic identity must be provided for the dispensation of short term and annual licences for craft fitted with outboard engines above 10Hp.

10. In the event of lost, stolen or damaged licences, a replacement fee of £13.90 will be charged. A Replacement Licence application form is obtainable from the Harbour Administration Office.
11. In the event of late submission of any events due to occur in Bristol Harbour, a fee of £127.50 will be charged for the issue of Notices to Mariners.
12. An administration fee of £119.65 will be charged for any transfer of licences, berthing or storage, agreed by the Harbour Authority.
13. An administration fee of £64.30 will be charged for refund of licence.
14. An administration fee of £76.40 will be charged for mailing services. For urgent request charge will be negotiated.
