**CONSTRUCTION OF ROAD HUMPS – LANGTON COURT ROAD, ST. ANNES  
(BRISLINGTON WEST WARD)**

NOTICE is hereby given that the City Council of Bristol in exercise of the powers conferred by section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 as amended, (hereinafter called ‘the Act’) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with section 90C(1) of the Act and those bodies or persons prescribed by the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 as amended (hereinafter called ‘the Regulations’) and in accordance with section 90C(2) of the Act, intends to construct a road hump at the location specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

The road hump specified in the Schedule to this Notice will extend over the full width of the carriageway (which will also be narrowed by virtue of footway buildouts at this location) and will be 75 millimetres in maximum height, subject to the tolerances permitted in the Regulations. The road hump specified in the Schedule to this Notice will be in the form of a speed table.

**Location of Road Hump/speed table**

**LANGTON COURT ROAD** - extending across the whole width of the carriageway (as narrowed by associated footway buildouts) and along its length from a point 47 metres from its junction with Salisbury Road north westwards for a distance of 8.5 metres
