### (VARIOUS ROADS, WICK ROAD/WHITBY ROAD AREA, BRISLINGTON EAST AND BRISLINGTON WEST WARDS, CITY OF BRISTOL) (24 HOUR MAIN CARRIAGEWAY CLEARWAY) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) (BUS PARKING PLACES) (CAR CLUB PARKING PLACES) (DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES) ORDER 202-

The City Council of Bristol hereby gives NOTICE it proposes to make a traffic order, the effect of which would be:-

1. to revise prohibition of waiting arrangements for vehicles in **Bloomfield Road, Langton Court Road and Langton Road**;
2. to revise no stopping prohibitions on school entrance markings in **Bloomfield Road and Langton Court Road**;
3. to revise the disabled persons' parking place in **Bloomfield Road** (which would be moved north eastwards); and
4. to remove the bus parking place in **Bloomfield Road**.
