

Allocation Statement for Blaise Primary School 2025

As Blaise Primary School was oversubscribed, the criteria stated in their published admissions policy available on the school and Local Authority websites have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the school.

108 on-time applications (50 x 1st preferences, 32 x 2nd preferences, 26 x 3rd preferences) have been received for Blaise Primary School, which has an Admission Number of 60.

How the Initial Allocation of Places was made

0 places were requested by the SEN Team for a pupil with an Education Health and Care Plan.

60 places have been offered to the following children:

1. Children in the care of the Local Authority or who were previously in Care but immediately after being in Care became subject to an adoption order, child arrangement order or special guardianship order. (0 place)
2. Those children with siblings already at Blaise Primary School and who will still be there in September 2025. (24 places)
3. Those children living closest to Blaise Primary School as measured in a direct line from the home address to the school. (36 places) The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 1.836km

Infant class size prejudice appeals - effects of infant Class Size legislation.

Appeals for Blaise Primary School will be heard based on infant class size prejudice as the school will have two Reception classes each containing 30 pupils.
