

Allocation Statement for Breentry Primary School - September 2025

As Breentry Primary School was oversubscribed, the criteria stated in their published admissions policy available on the school and Local Authority websites have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the school.

114 on-time applications (64 x 1st preferences, 31 x 2nd preferences, 19 x 3rd preferences) have been received for Breentry Primary School, which has an Admission Number of 30.

How the Initial Allocation of Places was made

1 place was reserved at the request of the SEN Team for pupils with Education Health and Care Plans.

The remaining 29 places have been offered to the following children:

1. Children in the care of the Local Authority or who were previously in Care but immediately after being in Care became subject to an adoption order, child arrangement order or special guardianship order. (2 places)
2. Those children with siblings already at Breentry Primary School and who will still be there in September 2025. (17 places)
3. Those children living closest to Breentry Primary School as measured in a direct line from the home address to the school. (10 places) The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 0.395km

Infant class size prejudice appeals - effects of infant Class Size legislation.

Appeals for Breentry Primary School will be heard based on infant class size prejudice as the school will have one Reception classes containing 30 pupils.
