(ABINGDON ROAD, HILLFIELDS WARD, CITY OF BRISTOL) (SCHOOL STREET PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) AND (ACTON ROAD, HILLFIELDS WARD, CITY OF BRISTOL) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 202-

The City Council of Bristol hereby gives NOTICE that it proposes to make a traffic order, the effect of which would be to amend the operating hours of the existing School Street prohibition of driving in **Abingdon Road** to operate between 8:30 and 9:10 am and between 2:50 and 3:40 pm Monday to Friday (term times only).

Note: the existing one way operating in Acton Road would be brought forward into the new order unchanged.
