How long we will keep your data for:

We will hold this data for a period on 12 months, after this period your information will be archived.

Why we need to collect your data:

We will use this information for the purpose of managing you hire agreement.

Who we share your data with and why:

Your **name**, **email address and phone number and bank details** may be used internally to Bristol City Council.

If we have obtained your consent to use your data:

You are freely able to withdraw your consent for us to process your information at any given time. However, removing your consent from any of the following: **name**, **phone number**, **email address and postal address** will result in you not being able to apply for or hire a sports pitch/green in a park or open space.

Your rights as a data subject:

You have the right to request access to your data and where data is found to be inaccurate to have that data corrected. In certain circumstances you have the right to have data held about you erased, or the use of it restricted. You may be able to object to processing, and may also have the right to have your data transferred to another data controller.
