

Bristol City Council Examination note – Protected Open Space

This note has been prepared by Bristol City Council as part of the examination of the Bristol Local Plan in response to the Inspectors' document **IN10: Inspectors Interim Post-Hearing Advice**

This note addresses the following specific action points from the Inspectors' note:

- **Policy GI1 and related LGS designations should be deleted, with any areas which fall into the definition of open space in the NPPF reverting to Reserved Open Space status.**
- **This may not apply to all proposed LGS and the Council should be careful to exclude any area that does not fall within that definition. This exercise will not alter any other designations a site is subject to.**
- **Main modifications to this effect should be added to the schedule. Consequential amendments to the Policies Map will also be necessary.**
- **Alongside the MM schedule, the Council should also send us details of the sites that are to revert to ROS and any which would fall outside that designation and will be deallocated.**

1. Definition of open space and criteria for assessment

1.1 The glossary that supports the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) sets out the definition of Open Space:

All open space of public value, including not just land, but also areas of water (such as rivers, canals, lakes and reservoirs) which offer important opportunities for sport and recreation and can act as a visual amenity.

1.2 National Planning Practice Guidance (Paragraph: 001 Reference ID: 37-001-20140306, Open space, sports and recreation facilities, public rights of way and local green space, National Planning Practice Guidance) sets out the following:

Open space, which includes all open space of public value, can take many forms, from formal sports pitches to open areas within a development, linear corridors and country parks. It can provide health and recreation benefits to people living and working nearby; have an ecological value and contribute to green infrastructure¹ (see National Planning Policy Framework paragraph 171, as well as being an important part of the landscape and setting of

built development, and an important component in the achievement of sustainable development (see National Planning Policy Framework paragraphs 7-9).

1.3 Having regard to this guidance, the council has used the following criteria to confirm whether sites are 'open space of public value' for the purposes of the NPPF and therefore suitable for designation as Reserved Open Green Space:

Role	Criteria
Health and Recreation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Evidence of some recreational use (including allotments or school playing pitches); and,- Access to support an appreciation of the natural environment, or space to exercise and socialise.
Ecological value	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Site contains ecological designations; and/or- The open green space forms a key part of a Wildlife Network Site (WNS) or identified formal Green Infrastructure Link
Urban Landscape	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- A significant connection to important landscape feature (i.e. hillside, gorges or areas with substantial tree cover); and/or- Contribution towards local visual amenity or local character, demonstrated via high visibility from the public domain and/or local views of the site.
Townscape and Cultural Heritage Value	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Open green space contribution to local character, with the site being integral to urban design.

1.4 The same criteria were used to identify Reserved Open Green Spaces for designation in the Local Green Space and Reserved Open Green Space Topic Paper (November 2023) (TPC005) and the Bristol Local Plan Publication Version (November 2023) (CSD001-CSD003).

2. Outcome of assessment

2.1 Appendix A of this examination note takes each site previously proposed for designation as Local Green Space in turn and carefully assesses it against the criteria above.

2.2 All of the sites previously proposed for designation as Local Green Space have been found to meet the criteria of Reserved Open Green Space. As such, the Council proposes that all of the sites would revert to Reserved Open Green Space through a main modification to the local plan. This proposed modification is shown in the draft schedule of suggested main modifications.
