CONSTRUCTION OF ROAD HUMPS
VARIOUS ROADS, HAWKFIELD ROAD AREA, HARTCLIFFE & WITHYWOOD
AND HENGROVE & WHITCHURCH PARK WARDS, CITY OF BRISTOL

NOTICE is hereby given that the City Council of Bristol in exercise of the powers conferred by section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 as amended, (hereinafter called 'the Act') and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with section 90C (1) of the Act and those bodies or persons prescribed by the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 as amended (hereinafter called 'the Regulations') and in accordance with section 90C (2) of the Act, intends to construct road humps at the locations specified in Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 to this Notice.

The road humps specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice will be in the form of speed cushions 1.8 metres wide, 2.0 metres in length and 75 millimetres in maximum height, subject to the tolerances permitted in the Regulations.

The road humps (speed tables) specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice will extend over the full width of the carriageway and will be 75 millimetres in maximum height, subject to the tolerances permitted in the Regulations.

SCHEDULE 1
Locations of Road Humps (speed cushions in groups of 2)

- HAWKFIELD ROAD**
- at a point 70 metres south of Whitchurch Lane
 - at a point 70 metres north of Fulford Road
 - at a point 65 metres south of Briscoes Avenue
 - at a point 185 metres south of Briscoes Avenue

SCHEDULE 2
Locations of Road Humps (speed tables)

BRISCOES AVENUE AND HAWKFIELD ROAD

At the junction of Briscoes Avenue and Hawkfield Road along their respective lengths as follows:-

- (a) **Briscoes Avenue** - from Hawkfield Road westwards for 15 metres
- (b) **Hawkfield Road** - from 9 metres south of Briscoes Avenue to 9 metres north of the said junction

BUTTERFLY LANE AND HAWKFIELD ROAD

At the junction of Butterfly Lane and Hawkfield Road along their respective lengths as follows:-

- (a) **Butterfly Lane** - from Hawkfield Road eastwards for 6 metres
- (b) **Hawkfield Road** - from 3 metres south of Butterfly Lane to 8 metres north of the said junction

FULFORD ROAD AND HAWKFIELD ROAD

At the junction of Fulford Road and Hawkfield Road along their respective lengths as follows:-

- (a) **Fulford Road** - from Hawkfield Road westwards for 18 metres
- (b) **Hawkfield Road** - from 13 metres south of Fulford Road to 9 metres north of said junction

HAWKFIELD ROAD - from 127 metres north of Butterfly Lane northwards for 14 metres

WHITCHURCH LANE AND HAWKFIELD ROAD

At the junction of Whitchurch Lane and Hawkfield Road along their respective lengths as follows:-

- (a) **Whitchurch Lane** - from Hawkfield Road westwards for 17 metres
- (b) **Hawkfield Road** - from 14 metres south of Whitchurch Lane to 8 metres north of the said junction
